# Reservations

All seats on NSW TrainLink Regional train and coach services must be booked in advance. Some coach services cannot be booked separately and must be booked with a train service.

When you book online, you can see services available on your preferred dates, ticket options and current sale fares. You can pay securely with a credit or debit card.

#### Visit transportnsw.info/regional

Please book over the phone or in person if you:

- use a wheelchair or require help to board
- are booking for a group of 10 or more people
- require seating for small children
- · are travelling with items such as bikes and boards
- want to book a sleeping berth.

Call **13 22 32** between 7am and 10pm or book your ticket at selected train stations or accredited travel agents.

# **Regional train sleeping compartments**

For overnight trips, you can book a sleeping berth on trains that travel between Melbourne, Sydney, Casino and Brisbane.

There are shared toilet and shower facilities between compartments and each has a call button to contact crew throughout the night. Bookings include bed linen, towels, toiletries and a complimentary breakfast.

During the day, sleepers convert to daysitter compartments with three seats.

# Luggage

Each passenger may bring up to three pieces of luggage, including one piece of hand luggage and up to two pieces of large and/or heavy luggage.

#### Train services

Hand luggage:

- 1 piece per passenger, up to 5kg
- Up to 30cm high x 50cm long x 30cm wide
- Must be kept on your lap, in the overhead racks or seat pocket

Large and/or heavy luggage:

- 2 pieces per passenger, 5-20kg per piece
- Up to 60cm high x 70cm long x 50cm wide.

#### **Coach services**

Hand luggage:

- 1 piece per passenger, up to 5kg
- Up to 30cm high x 50cm long x 30cm wide
- Must be kept on your lap or under the seat in front

Large and/or heavy luggage:

- 2 pieces per passenger, 5-20kg per piece
- Up to 60cm high x 70cm long x 50cm wide
- Give your luggage to the driver to be stowed prior to boarding.

Luggage can be checked in at all attended NSW TrainLink stations with scheduled Regional services at least 30 minutes before departure and must be clearly labelled.

Garbage bags, boxes and tea chests are not permitted. Soft bags must be no more than 15kg, medium-sized, zip-up and contain clothing and soft items only.

## Banned luggage items

For safety reasons, the below items are not permitted in your luggage:

- Household items and appliances
- Plants or plant matter
- Perishable items including meat, seafood, fruit and vegetables.

Dangerous goods, including but not limited to:

- · compressed gases, and flammable liquids and solids
- oxidising materials, poisons and infectious substances
- corrosives
- explosives and radioactive materials.

#### Overweight luggage and excess items will be refused.

#### Pre-booked luggage

Travelling with an oversized item such as a bike or surfboard? You must pre-book by calling **13 22 32**. Charges apply.

Bicycles (dismantled, in approved container), snow skis and poles, snowboards, surfboards in a protective bag all have a height limit of 2m.

Pre-booked luggage must be checked in 60 minutes before departure.

# Meals, drinks and snacks

There is a buffet car on all long distance trains that serves hot and cold refreshments and meals throughout the trip.

Food and drink cannot be consumed on Regional coach services.

The crew can serve meals to any customer with a disability that prevents them leaving their seat. If you have a special dietary requirement, place your main meal order as soon as possible to avoid disappointment.

BYO alcohol is not permitted on any NSW TrainLink train or coach service, or at stations. Fines may apply. Conditions and responsible service of alcohol applies.
